Presidents Report:

- Working on holding the January meeting in person/Tracy.
- Discussed at the CAHA meeting was about the Tier II teams that were cut/potentially playing as tournament teams.
- Recommendation was made to add a NORCAL SafeSPort Coordinator to the NORCAL website, and lay out the chain of command to follow.
- o <u>SafeSport:</u>
 - Safe Sport is a nationally "all sport" run program, not USA Hockey.
 - Have had parents bypassing USA Hockey and going directly to SafeSPort.
 - SafeSport charges USA Hockey \$1500 for every claim received. We need to run complaints through NORCAL first to validate whether the claims should be sent on.

 - We are currently without a SafeSport coordinator for NORCAL. Please contact Dan Granata if interested or know anyone in your club that is.
 - ALL clubs must have their own SafeSport coordinator that handles complaints and refers on to NORCAL.

o <u>Development Camp</u>

- Arrangements are made. WIII be reaching out for 10-11 evaluators for the event.
- Mark Mauro is organizing the officials.
- Davis/Justin will be the coaches for the Development Camp.

o Parent Behavior:

- Parent behavior needs to be controlled. Still having lots of issues.
- Officials need to stop games and suspend.
- This is really hurting volunteers getting involved as well as its not appropriate for our players.
- Coaches need to tone down the player celebration on the ice for goals when teams are way ahead on the scoreboard.
- USA Hockey Code of Conduct-DAn will send out this flyer for the clubs to distribute to parents.
- Harsh language is occurring on the ice. This needs to be curbed now. WIII have heavy consequences which could include hearings, suspensions, etc.
- NORCAL has a ZERO tolerance for hate language and/or harassment.

TREASURER-Robert Grande

- P/L looks good. Not all the fees are showing up yet.
- 3 clubs are still owing fees.
- Balance on accounts looking good.

- The information on the scoresheets by managers needs work. Teresa has addressed with the club registrars.
- There will be a "Tournament Roster Late Fee" of \$200 per team if rosters are not submitted appropriately on time.
- Teresa will send out email outlining the USA Hockey requirements for rosters discussed today.
- CEP deadline is December 31st, 2022. Coaches MUST be done or will be dropped off all rosters until compliant. Registrars are able to run a report to see what coaches are in need of CEP completion.
- The last set of coaches clinics will be posted December 1st.

MITE COORDINATOR-Darren Attebery-

- Mite Jamboree went great. No issues. Stockton was very helpful
- Looking forward to the Jamboree in Vacaville in January.

SCHEDULER-Tyler Shaffar -NO REPORT

NORHOA-Bill Palter

- Still really shot referees in outlining areas.
- Last clinic for this season has been held.
- Still canceling approx. 5 games a week (mostly adult) due to referee shortage.
- Per DAn-NORCAL is doing all we can to avoid canceling any games. (Offering extra travel money, more game money, etc.)
- USA hockey has a specific time frame allowed to hold training seminars, so holding early or later is not an option.
- Problems still exist that referees do not want to officiate certain games due to bad coach behavior, problem parents, etc.
- Recommendation was made to start recruiting campaigns early(ASAP) with a program of "Save This Date" for upcoming seminars next season.
- Discussion/brainstorming took place about the referee shortage and ways to incentivise.

- HS Discussion-
 - Blaine Muchart/Stockton sent out an email to all outlining his thoughts on areas of improvement and recommendations for the HS league.
 - \circ $\;$ Per Shane: There used to be a HS board. Dissolved when COVID hit.
 - Shane agrees that the board needs to be recreated to address issues.
 - Districting lines were a priority this year, will be focusing on establishing the board next season
 - (TOM)-
 - HS has to grow to expand hockey in CA.
 - All HS leagues run under the authority of CAHA.
 - HS is a growing process-please bring any questions/concerns to Shane/Rosemary.
 - JV-looking at going to a home/away version. It is currently hard to have a pre-season with a 14 game season.
 - Looking at the possibility of starting the season early, but clubs would have to set aside HS specific ice slots.
 - Considering moving HS league to the spring season to alleviate alot of issues.
